Introduction

John Winston Lennon

was born on October 9th 1940. His father was away and his <u>Aunt Mimi</u> raised him. He formed a band named the Quarry Men, with friends from school. Throughout time the other Beatles joined and the others people left. He was married twice. Once to <u>Cynthia Powell</u> in 1962 and they had a son named <u>Julian</u>. He was the one that inspired <u>Lucy</u> In <u>The Sky With Diamonds</u>. His second wife was Yoko Ono. They were married in 1969 and had one child, <u>Sean</u>. On December 8, 1980 he was assassinated by <u>Mark Chapman</u>, at the age of 40.

James Paul McCartney

was born on June 18, 1942. Paul's mother died when he was a teenager. He met John at a performance by John. They got together and started playing. Then Paul introduced George to John. He was married to Linda Eastman. His writing style was more of the slow love songs, although there were many exceptions, Helter Skelter, Sgt. Pepper, etc., this was his main style

George Harrison

was born on February 25, 1943. He is the youngest Beatle. He was friends with Paul before he joined the Quarrymen. He impressed them with his guitar. The first song he sang was Chains. Over time his song writing skills improved. He had two of the most popular songs on Abbey Road.

Richard Starkey

was born on July 7, 1940. He was the oldest Beatle. He replaced Pete Best as the Beatles drummer in 1962 and was the last Beatle to join. He was not the drummer for Love Me Do; it was Andy White playing the drums on the released version. The first song he sang was Boys. The first song he wrote was If You've Got Trouble. It never made a Beatles album. He is noted for singing Yellow Submarine and With A Little Help From My Friends as well as writing Octopus's Garden. He also came up with the title for A Hard Day's Night. After they had been working all day he came outside and said to a reporter, "It's been a hard day," and looking up he noticed it was dark he said, "'s night.
